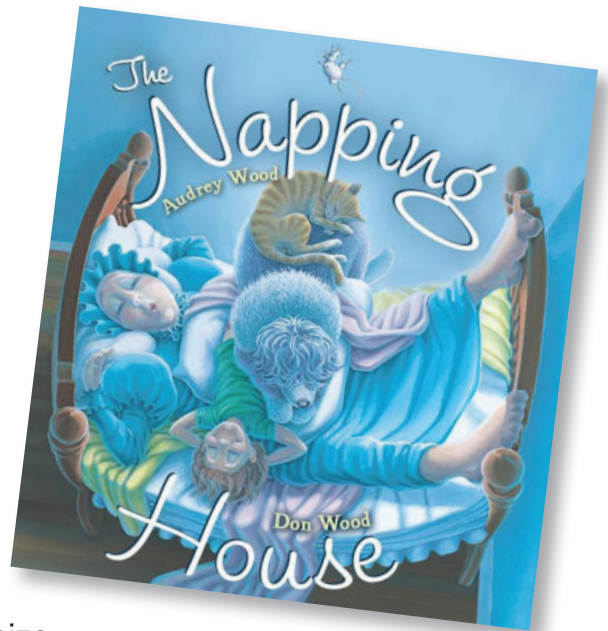


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

- 7 **SORT** objects from around the house based on size
- 8 **RETELL** the story together by using the illustrations
- 9 **COUNT** how many people and animals end up in the bed
- 10 **POINT** at and share the names of all the objects in the bedroom

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

Act out parts of the story.

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.
