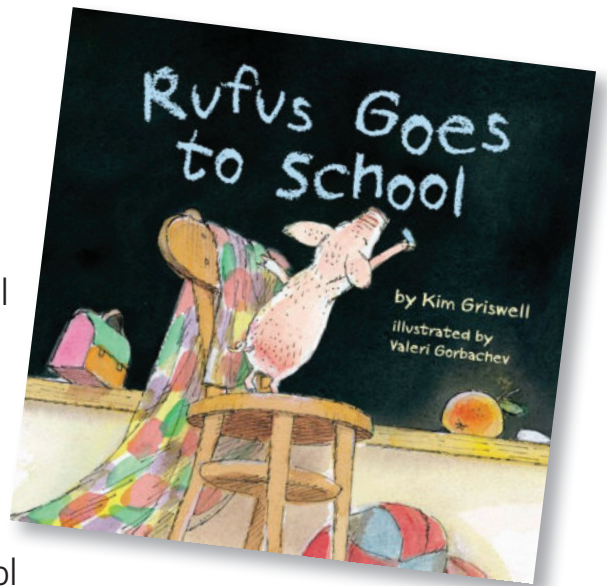


# 10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

- 1 **TALK** about different kinds of behavior and rules
- 2 **WRITE** a list together of things to bring to school
- 3 **SHARE** a story about your first day at school
- 4 **PLAY** school with your child
- 5 **VISIT** your local school
- 6 **ACT** out some silly things a pig might do at school
- 7 **DRAW** a picture of your perfect classroom or school
- 8 **SING** “The Wheels on the Bus” after reading the book
- 9 **ASK** your child to tell you a story based on the pictures in a book
- 10 **POINT** to the sentence “No pigs in school” every time it appears and have your child say it with you

### FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

1

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
