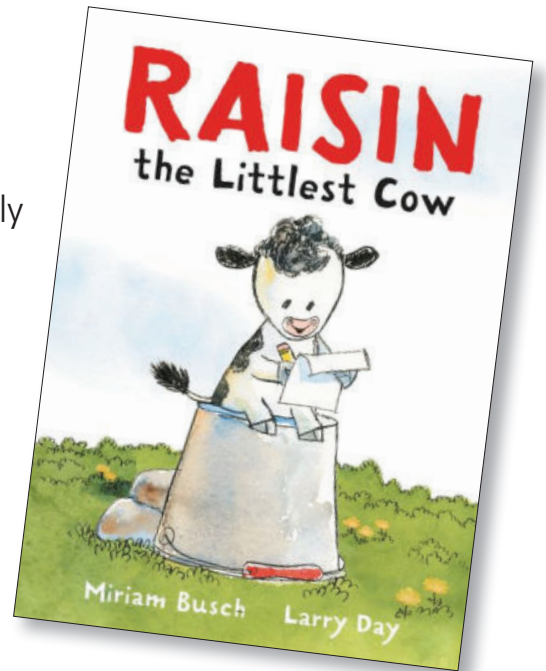


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

Raisin, the Littlest Cow

by Miriam Busch; illustrated by Larry Day

- 1 **TRY** to make each other laugh by doing something silly
- 2 **WRITE** a list of your child's favorite things
- 3 **SHARE** the story behind your child's name
- 4 **LEARN** more about cows
- 5 **SING** "Old MacDonald has a Farm" together
- 6 **DRAW** a picture of a little cow and a big cow
- 7 **ACT** out the story with things from around the house
- 8 **LIST** together all the things your child can do without help
- 9 **CREATE** a new story with your child about Raisin & Raindrop
- 10 **TALK** about Raisin's different expressions and feelings throughout the book



FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
