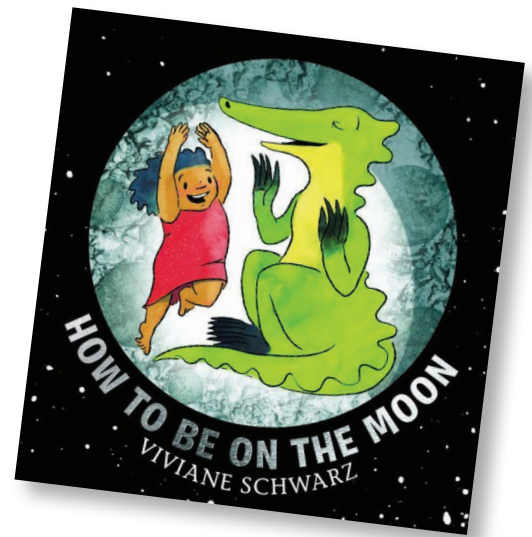


# 10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

## How to Be on the Moon

- 1 **LOOK** at pictures of the moon.
- 2 **COUNT** backward from 10 together.
- 3 **DRAW** what you think space looks like.
- 4 **SING** "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star".
- 5 **PRETEND** you're on the moon. What do you see?
- 6 **PLAN** a trip to space. What would you take?
- 7 **WRITE** a packing list for a trip to space.
- 8 **MAKE** a sandwich (for real or out of craft materials).
- 9 **TRACE** the path of the rocket ship on its way to the moon.
- 10 **BUILD** a rocket ship out of materials from around the house.

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
