- **IMITATE** the action words (pranced, skipped, etc.).

- **DISCUSS** the letter Z from Alfonzo's name. How do you write it? What does it sound like?

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

Act out parts of the story.

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

Retell the story using the illustrations.
